③ "Display" Connection port to signal receiver

"Source" Connection port to signal source



#### Installation

- Step 1. Connect the cable from signal receiver to the repeater marked with "Display" Signal receiver: such as HDTV, Projector, etc.
- Step 2. Connect the cable from signal source to the repeater marked with "Source" Signal source: such as DVD player, Set Top Box, Satellite, etc.

Step 3. Turn on the power of signal receiver and signal source.

Please make sure all cables are workable before connecting to the repeater.
